

**FAUNISTIC RECORDS FROM THE CZECH REPUBLIC – 147****Lepidoptera:****Eriocraniidae**

*Eriocrania sangii* (Wood, 1891). Moravia mer. occ., Vržanov, Pahorek u Vržanova Nature Reserve (6660), 27.iv.1994, 1 ♀, J. Šumpich leg., det. et coll. This overlooked species was recorded in most European countries, absent in the Balkan and Iberian Peninsulas (Heath & Karsholt 1996). In Central Europe known from Austria (Huemer & Tarmann 1993), Germany (Sutter 2000), Poland (Buszko & Nowacki 2000) and Bohemia (Novák et al. 1997). New species for Moravia.

**Gelechiidae**

*Helcystogramma triannulella* (Herrich-Schäffer, 1854). Bohemia bor., Litoměřice, Bílé stráně Nature Reserve (5450), 12.x.2000, 1 ♂, M. Žemlička leg., det. et coll., J. Šumpich revid. Thermophilic species, widely distributed in southern Europe, absent in northern parts of Central Europe. In the Czech Republic known only from Moravia (Zimmermann 1922). New species for Bohemia.

**Pyralidae**

*Asalebria fumella* (Eversmann, 1844). Bohemia or.: Podhradí near Třemošnice, Lichnice a Kaňkovy hory Nature Reserve (6159), 29.vi.1998, 1 ♂, J. Šumpich leg., det. et coll.; Hradec Králové – Svinář, Dehetník Hill (5761), 14.vi.2000, 1 ♂, M. Mikát leg., det. et coll. Known only from Central Europe and Baltic countries (Speidel 1996). In the Czech Republic recorded locally in southern Moravia (Laštůvka et al. 1993). New species for Bohemia.

**Geometridae**

*Crocallis tusciaria* (Borkhausen, 1793). Moravia bor. or., Dolní Bečva (6575-76), 18.vii.1931, 1 ♀, Herman leg., O. Jakeš det. et coll., M. Dvořák revid. Very rare and local species in Central Europe, recorded from Germany, Hungary, southern Poland, Slovakia and Switzerland (Müller 1996). One uncertain record was published from Austria (Huemer & Tarmann 1993). In the Czech Republic known only from Bohemia (Krampl et al. 1980). First record from Moravia.

**Noctuidae**

*Polyphaenis sericata* (Esper, 1787). Moravia mer. or., Luhačovice (68-6972), 10.vii.1960, 1 ♀, V. Vala leg. et det., coll. V. Vala, deposited in Regional Museum Mikulov, M. Dvořák revid.

Thermophilic species, occurring especially in southern Europe; in Central Europe known from Austria, Germany, Hungary, southern Poland, Slovakia, Switzerland and southern Ukraine (Laštůvka 1998, Nowacki 1998, Nowacki & Fibiger 1996, Rakosy 1996). First record from the Czech Republic.
